Chairman Pruner called the meeting to order at 4:40 p.m.

**Additional Funding for Yolo County Fire Districts:**

Chairman Pruner thanked Supervisor Villegas for attending today's meeting and thanked the Supervisor for his candid discussions with our Fire Chief, Commissioners, and the District Advocate. The Chairman stated that we, as a District, are trying to be part of the Yolo County fire service community but are uncomfortable with the recent aggressive rhetoric directed at the Board of Supervisors by the Fire Chief's Association. Chairman Pruner added that, notwithstanding our objections to the rhetoric, we don't want to be left out of any additional funding. The Chairman further stated that, in an effort to achieve this goal, it is our desire to open a direct line of communications with the Board of Supervisors. The Supervisor acknowledged the sudden change of tone associated with the County Fire Chief's lobbying of his Board. A lengthy discussion ensued that included, but was not limited to, the District's equipment replacement plan, the current MOU presented by the Yolo County Fire Chief's Association, potential funding sources, the limited resources available for public services in Yolo County, the upcoming LAFCO review, and the Clarksburg Fire District's positioning in funding allocation negotiations. Chairman Pruner thanked the Supervisor for his attendance at this meeting and the candid discussion on the aforementioned topics. Supervisor Villegas stated that he will keep our District informed as these issues progress.

With no further business before the Commission, it was moved by Commissioner Kirchhoff and seconded by Commissioner Pylman to adjourn the meeting. The motion was approved unanimously by a roll call vote. The meeting was adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
